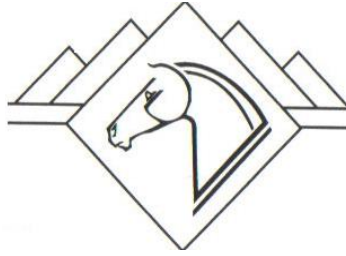

SOUTH WILLAMETTE EQUINE WELLNESS PROGRAM

We are offering a convenient equine health program. Our wellness program focuses on preventative medicine and is designed to allow us to identify and treat problems before they become a threat to your horse's health. Enrolling in our wellness program ensures that your horse receives the best in veterinary health care and also qualifies participants to receive a 10% discount on all preventative products and services we provide.

In addition, participants may qualify for 10% discounts on equine mortality/theft insurance offered by West Coast Equine Insurance Services. Please contact Rich Maggard or Tana Baker at (800) 499-3717, or visit their website at www.wcequine.com. Be sure to let them know you are enrolling in South Willamette's wellness program to receive a prompt, discounted insurance proposal from one of their excellent carriers. The annual physical exam for program enrollment will also be used for an insurance examination (if insurance is obtained within the first 30 days of program enrollment).

To qualify for the discounts in our wellness program, we must provide the following minimum preventative care procedures for your horse(s):

- ❖ **Annual physical** examinations and nutritional counseling.
- ❖ **Annual dental exam** and prescribed treatment when indicated.
- ❖ **Annual vaccinations** appropriate for the horse given his/her age, usage and stabling environment.
*Some vaccinations may need to be repeated every six months, depending on environment.
- ❖ **Deworming program** as directed by enrolling veterinarian.
*Deworming program may be one of three options:
 1. Evidence based deworming: participants must submit at least two fecal samples, i.e.: spring and fall to quantify parasite egg shedding. Deworming will then be prescribed as indicated. Alternatively participants may elect to deworm spring and fall

with ivermectin or moxidectin/praziquantel pastes and submit one fecal sample per year.

2. Interval deworming: enrolled horse(s) will be dewormed four times per year with anthelmintics directed by SWVC.
3. Continuous daily deworming with Strongid 2X.

*Required during grazing season along with ivermectin or moxidectin /praziquantel pastes, administered spring and fall.

*All deworming products must be purchased from SWVC for documentation and compliance purposes.

**10% discount will apply to all preventative equine deworming products and vaccinations for enrolled horses.

Qualifiers

1. Availability of insurance is subject to normal company underwriting guidelines based on age, use, and prior health history.
2. Payment in full at the time of services is required in order to receive your 10% discount.
3. All of these program requirements need to be documented, administered and/or purchased through SWVC.

Please call our office with any inquiries about SWVC Equine Wellness or to set up an appointment. We feel very strongly that by utilizing our veterinarians to examine your horse annually to help assess his/her nutritional needs, direct their parasite control and vaccination schedules, and manage their annual dental care, we can greatly improve their overall health and performance as well as reduce their risk for life threatening conditions such as colic.
